5. QUALIFICATIONS OF CONTESTANTS : -

5.1 For Sub-Junior Boys & Girls aged Under-12 Years old based on 31-12-2022 are eligible – Born after 01-01-2011.

5.2 Holder of RED-ONE Color Belt and above Certificate with **Color Belt TFI ID CARD**.

5.3 The Participant with TFI I.D. Card shall be recommended by Affiliated State Assn, Citizen of India and Domicile of the Representing State holding Valid ID Card

5.4 The copy of Corporation / Municipal Birth Certificate, TFI Black Belt ID card should be enclosed compulsorily.

5.5 Participants from the State Teams in the Sub-Junior Categories in the National Sub-Junior Taekwondo Championship must be the Medal winners in the respective Wt. Category of the State Championship conducted during the year 2022-23. The first preference will go to the Gold Medal Winner, if he/she is unable to participate; then Silver medalist should be the next to be selected. Others will be denied entry into the Championship.

8. METHOD OF COMPETITIONS FOR RECOGNIZED (Cut-off System) : -

- 8.1 There should be at least 4 States with not less than 4 contestants in each Category.
- 8.2 Cut-Off System shall consist of Preliminary, Semi-Final & Final Rounds.
- 8.3 Cut off system preliminary: When 20 or more contestants are participating; competition shall start from preliminary round with division of groups at different courts.
- 8.4 Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae, and, half of them from each group shall advance to semi-final based on their points. In preliminary round, each group might be judged by different group of judges. If the number of contestants is odd, then round the number of contestants to make even. Ex- If there are 13 contestants in group, then 13 contestants as considered as 14 contestants and 7 contestants shall advance to semi-final.
- 8.5 Cut off system semi-final: When 9 to 19 contestants are participating; competition shall start from semi-final round, Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae, and, 8 of them shall be advanced to final based on their points.
- 8.6 Cut off system final: When 8 or fewer contestants are participating; competition shall start from final round. Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae, and, the top four contestants / pair/ team shall be awarded prizes based on their points. 3rd and 4th places are awarded with bronze medals.

9. ENTRY FEES : -

Rs. 2000/- for Individual

Rs. 2000/- for Pair

Rs. 3000/- for Team

Which includes Boarding & Lodging during the Championship



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10. IMPORTANT DATES & INFORMATIONS :-

- 10.1 In case of **REPLACEMENT** of an injured athlete, an STA may replace this athlete no later than 15th March 2023.

11. BOARDING & LODGING FACILITIES :-

- 11.1 After Accreditation and Registration of Teams, dormitory type of accommodation will be provided by from 28th March' 2023 Morning to 1st April' 2023 upto only 08:00 AM by the Organizers whereas Food will be given from 28th March' 2023 Dinner to 31st March' 2023 Dinner.

12. APPOINTMENT OF TECHNICAL OFFICIALS :-

The required number of Officials will be appointed by TFI. These Officials will be provided Boarding and Lodging during the Championships by the Organizers but Remuneration will be provided by the TFI from the Entry Fee so collected.

13. DRAWING OF LOTS :-

- 13.1 Team Officials should be present for Drawing of Lots. Absentees will be substituted by T.F.I Officials. **OR** Drawing of Lots may be conducted by random computerized drawing or by random manual drawing of lots. The method and order of drawing shall be determined by the Technical Delegate.
- 13.2 A certain number of contestants shall be seeded based on their achievements
- 13.3 At the end of the designated registration date the TFI shall announce the list of registered contestants in each Poomsae category.
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14. SECURITY DEPOSIT, EXTRA TEAM MEMBERS & TRANSPORTATION :-

- 14.1 A Security Deposit of Rs. 2,000.00 should be deposited by each Team at the Time of Registration which will be refunded during departure after clearing the cost of any loss or damage of Stadium / Accommodation Property, if any.
- 14.2 Apart from the Team Members, strictly Accommodation and Food will not be provided to the Extra Members. Extra Accommodation is not available. Please make your own arrangements for the extra members.

15. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS :-

15.1 Individual Awards

Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective classifications and weight divisions of the pertinent championships:

- Ist Place : Gold Medal
IInd Place : Silver Medal
IIIrd Place : Bronze Medal
IIIRD Place : Bronze Medal

15.2 Team Awards

Based on the point system below, the top five (3) teams of the Boy's division and the top five (3) teams of the Girl's division will receive trophies:

RATIONALE	NO. OF POINTS AWARDED
For every contestant who passed the official registration	1
For every win (including byes)	1



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For every Gold Medal	7
For every Silver Medal	3
For every Bronze Medal	1

Other prizes, such as the "Good Playing Spirit Prize", "Active Participation Prize", MVPs and Best Referees and Best Coaches may be awarded to selected teams and individuals.

16. INDEMNITIES :-

It shall be responsibility of the respective State Associations to ensure that their contestants have validly completed the participation forms and have them signed by the Parents / Guardian and contestants indemnifying the Organizers, the Officials and other Contestants from any claims of injuries, losses, fatal of otherwise arising in the course of participation in this Championship or any activities thereto.

17. MEDICAL CONTROL :-

- 17.1 Use of Drugs or Doping by any Chemical substances prescribed in the WT Regulations for Doping Control is strongly prohibited.
- 17.2 The TFI will carry out Medical Doping Test among the Winners at Random Sampling and any Winner who refuses to undergo the testing or who proves to have committed a Breach of this Regulation shall be removed from the Final Standings, and a disciplinary action will be taken

18. PROTEST IF ANY :-

In case, there is Objection towards a Judgment, the concerned Coach / Manager must submit the Protest Application Form together with Prescribed Fee of Rs. 1000.00 (Non-Refundable) to the Board of Arbitration within ten minutes after the pertinent contest. Deliberation will be done as per WT Rules.
