28th to 31st March' 2023 Indoor Hall, Sports Complex, University of Kota, Kota, Rajasthan

5. QUALIFICATIONS OF CONTESTANTS: -

- 5.1 For Cadet Boys & Girls aged between 12 to 14 Years old based on 31-12-2022 are eligible Born between 01-01-2008 to 31-12-2010.
- 5.2 Holder of BLACK BLET 1st Dan and above with Color Belt TFI ID CARD.
- 5.3 The Participant with TFI I.D. Card shall be recommended by Affiliated State Assn, Citizen of India and Domicile of the Representing State holding Valid ID Card
- 5.4 The copy of Corporation / Municipal Birth Certificate, TFI Black Belt ID card should be enclosed compulsorily.
- 5.5 Participants from the State Teams in the Cadet Categories in the National Cadet Taekwondo Championship must be the Medal winners in the respective Wt. Category of the State Championship conducted during the year 2022-23. The first preference will go to the Gold Medal Winner, if he/she is unable to participate; then Silver medalist should be the next to be selected. Others will be denied entry into the Championship.

6. COMPETITION RULES: -

- 6.1 World Taekwondo Latest Competition Rules effective from 1st September' 2022.
- 6.2 Single Elimination Tournament System.

7. CONTEST TIME: -

7.1 Option 1: 1 minute 30 seconds x 3 rounds with 1 minute break (in the event that the number of participating athletes is overwhelming and exceeds the expected number of athletes) for preliminaries till quarter-finals, and 2 minutes x 3 rounds with 1 minute break for semi-finals and finals.

9. WEIGH-IN: -

- 9.1 The general weigh-in of the contestants on the day of competition shall be organized one day prior to the competition. The time for the general weigh-in will be decided by the Organizing Committee and be informed at the head of team meeting. The duration of the general weigh-in shall be two (2) hours at the maximum.
- 9.2 The random weigh-in will take place at the venue in the morning of the competition. All contestants who pass the general weigh-in must be present for random weigh-in maximum two (2) hours before the start of the competition. Should a contestant fail to appear for the random weigh-in, he/she will be disqualified. The random weigh-in must be completed maximum thirty (30) minutes before the start of the competition each day.
- 9.3 The rate of selection for the random weigh-in shall be set forth in the outline of the championships or at the head of team meeting and subjects will be randomly selected by computerized system maximum two (2) hours before the start of the competition.
- 9.4 The random weigh-in shall be conducted with plus 5% tolerance of the contestant's weight category. Underweight shall not be subjected to random weigh-in.
- 9.5 Cadet contestant must be weighed with underwear(s) and 100 grams will be allowed to compensate.
- 9.6 General weigh-in shall be made once, however, one more weigh-in is granted within the time limit to any contestant who did not qualify the first time.
- 9.7 Weigh-In will be done at the designated time and venue. Absentees will be disqualified.

 Original, TFI ID Card & Accreditation Card must be produced at the time of Weigh in without which no weighing will be taken.

11. METHOD OF COMPETITIONS FOR RECOGNIZED (Cut-off

System):-

- 11.1 There should be at least 4 States with not less than 4 contestants in each Category.
- 11.2 Cut-Off System shall consist of Preliminary, Semi-Final & Final Rounds.
- 11.3 Cut off system preliminary: When 20 or more contestants are participating; competition shall start from preliminary round with division of groups at different courts.
- 11.4 Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae, and, half of them from each group shall advance to semi-final based on their points. In preliminary round, each group might be judged by different group of judges. If the number of contestants is odd, then round the number of contestants to make even. Ex- If there are 13 contestants in group, then 13 contestants as considered as 14 contestants and 7 contestants shall advance to semi-final.
- 11.5 Cut off system semi-final: When 9 to 19 contestants are participating; competition shall start from semi-final round, Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae, and, 8 of them shall be advanced to final based on their points.

Cut off system final: When 8 or fewer contestants are participating; competition shall start from final round. Contestants shall perform the two assigned compulsory Poomsae, and, the top four contestants / pair/ team shall be awarded prizes based on their points. 3rd and 4th places are awarded with bronze medals.

12. ENTRY FEES: -

KYORUGI

Rs. 2000/- for each Athlete (which includes Boarding & Lodging during the Championship)

POOMSAE

Rs. 2000/- for Individual

Rs. 2000/- for Pair

Rs. 3000/- for Team (which includes Boarding & Lodging during the Championship)

13. IMPORTANT DATES & INFORMATIONS: -

13.1 In case of **REPLACEMENT of an injured athlete**, an STA may replace this athlete no later than 15th March 2023.

14. BOARDING & LODGING FACILITIES: -

14.1 After Accreditation and Registration of Teams, dormitory type of accommodation will be provided by from 28th March' 2023 Morning to 1st April' 2023 upto only 08:00 AM by the Organizers whereas Food will be given from 28th March' 2023 Dinner to 31st March' 2023 Dinner.

15. PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT: -

The Organizers will provide Chest Guard and Head Gear only. The Contestants must wear their own WT & TFI approved Dobok, Groin Guard, Forearm Guard, and Shin Guards & Mouth Guard compulsorily.

16. APPOINTMENT OF TECHNICAL OFFICIALS: -

The required number of Officials will be appointed by TFI. These Officials will be provided Boarding and Lodging during the Championships by the Organizers but Remuneration will be provided by the TFI from the Entry Fee so collected.

17. DRAWING OF LOTS: -

- 17.1 Team Officials should be present for Drawing of Lots. Absentees will be substituted by T.F.I. Officials **OR** Drawing of Lots may be conducted by random computerized drawing or by random manual drawing of lots. The method and order of drawing shall be determined by the Technical Delegate.
- 17.2 A certain number of contestants shall be seeded based on their achievements.
- 17.3 At the end of the designated registration date the TFI shall announce the list of registered contestants in each weight category.
- 17.4 At the end of the designated registration date the TFI shall announce the list of registered contestants in each weight category.

18. SECURITY DEPOSIT, EXTRA TEAM MEMBERS & TRANSPORTATION: -

- 18.1 A Security Deposit of Rs. 2,000.00 should be deposited by each Team at the Time of Registration which will be refunded during departure after clearing the cost of any loss or damage of Stadium / Accommodation Property, if any.
- 18.2 Apart from the Team Members, strictly Accommodation and Food will not be provided to the Extra Members. Extra Accommodation is not available. Please make your own arrangements for the extra members.

19. CLASSIFICATION OF RESULTS

19.1 Individual Awards

Medals will be awarded to the top four athletes in the respective classifications and weight divisions of the pertinent championships:

19.2 Team Awards

Based on the point system below, the top three (3) teams of the Boy's division and the top three (3) teams of the Girl's division will receive trophies:

Other prizes, such as the "Good Fighting Spirit Prize", "Active Participation Prize", MVPs and Best Referees and Best Coaches may be awarded to selected teams and individuals.

20. INDEMNITIES: -

It shall be responsibility of the respective State Associations to ensure that their contestants have validly completed the participation forms and have them signed by the Parents / Guardian and contestants indemnifying the Organizers, the Officials and other Contestants from any claims of injuries, losses, fatal of otherwise arising in the course of participation in this Championship or any activities thereto.

21. MEDICAL CONTROL: -

- 21.1 Use of Drugs or Doping by any Chemical substances prescribed in the WT Regulations for Doping Control is strongly prohibited.
- 21.2 The TFI will carry out Medical Doping Test among the Winners at Random Sampling and any Winner who refuses to undergo the testing or who proves to have committed

22. PROTEST IF ANY: -

In case, there is Objection towards a Judgment, the concerned Coach / Manager must submit the Protest Application Form together with Prescribed Fee of Rs. 1000.00 (Non-Refundable) to the Board of Arbitration within ten minutes after the pertinent contest. Deliberation will be done as per WT Rules.
